2018 is the 100th Anniversary of the end of WW1

Thursday 8th November: 11 am There will be a "Field of Remembrance" event outside the Library involving many Malvern Schools and with prayers led by Rev Philip Johnson from St. Matthias. This will include small wooden crosses being planted by the children with the names of each of the 440 people from Malvern who died during WW1.

Saturday 10th November: 3 pm A free concert at Malvern Priory. Part of this will focus on a poem about the women left to keep agriculture going during WW1 whilst so many men were away.

Sunday 11th November: 9.30 am A Civic Service of Remembrance in Malvern Priory followed by a parade to the library for the Act of Remembrance at 10.45 am. The Act of Remembrance is at 11am.
