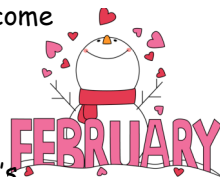

ST ANDREW'S HALL FLOOR

The hall floor is being replaced during the week 18th to 23rd February. Consequently during this time the hall will be out of use and some activities will be transferred into the church.

The new hall floor will be engineered oak, with a slight give in it. This should be suitable for the whole range of activities undertaken in the hall. We hope you like it and that you will help us to keep the new floor in good condition.

An offcut sample of the finished floor is available for inspection in Chase End. The new floor will go under the stage and, at least at first, only half of the stage will be put back to give more useable space. We hope that this arrangement will improve the hall.

The kitchen and two cupboards off the hall used for storing the tables and chairs will have a new vinyl floor covering. If you have any queries, please speak to Derek Barnes.
