Despite trying, we've been unable to recycle the old wood blocks from the St Andrew's church hall. So, we are offering bags of wood blocks for kindling to light fires for a donation to St Andrew's.

The bags of blocks are to the north of the hall. Pick one up and put a donation in the box at the back of St Andrew's (or Gift Aid it).

Note: The blocks are solid wood and have surface polish on one side and may have glue (not bitumen) on the other side. They are ideal for kindling, but should be burnt only in a **well ventilated** environment.
