


How do we live in relation to God?





Identity: I am a sinner

We are living under the threat of God's wrath and punishment and must appease him through strict adherence to his 'rules'

- If we are obedient... he will bless us.
- If we are disobedient, we will be punished and suffer.

Faith is about 'following the rules'





Identity: I am a manager (Post-Christian?)

God is a relatively distant God who has given us a 'divine manual' and principles & values for life. We follow these principles but it leaves little room or need for God himself.

Faith is about relying on us to apply these principles and morals... living a 'good life'



Identity: I am a consumer

God is a cosmic therapist or a divine 'slot machine.' He is there to meet my needs & fix my life.

Faith is about desiring God's supernatural help & his gifts, but not necessarily desiring Him.

It is about what God can do for us

"Consumerism with a Jesus sticker slapped on the bumper!"

Identity: I am a servant to fulfil God's calling God has called me to a specific mission and my primary call is to accomplish it


- Our value & significance comes from what we do and achieve FOR God.
- Danger is that the mission can become the goal rather than God himself.

Revelation 21:2-3 The new Jerusalem.



And I heard a loud voice from the throne saying "Now the dwelling of God is WITH men, and he will live WITH them. They will be his people and God himself will be WITH them and be their God.'

CREATION RESTORED

- Enoch (Genesis 5:23-24) 'Enoch walked WITH God 300 years...
- Moses (Exodus 33) met with God and talked to him face to face 'as a man speaks with a friend'
- Jesus Emmanuel "God WITH us"
- Disciples called (Mark 3:14) 'that they might be WITH him and that he might send them out
- Matthew 11:28 MSG
- ""...Walk WITH me and work WITH me—watch how I do it. Learn the unforced rhythms of grace. I won't lay anything heavy or ill-fitting on you. Keep company WITH me and you'll learn to live freely and lightly."
- Jesus promises the Holy Spirit (John 14:15-17)

"If you love me, you will obey what I command. And I will ask the Father and he will give you another Counsellor to be WITH you for ever – the Spirit of truth"

1) Our Goal is not to 'use' God or 'be used' by God,
but our Goal is to be WITH God.

John Piper.... "The gospel is not a way to get people to heaven; it is a way to get people to God. It is a way to overcome every obstacle to everlasting joy in God. If we don't want God above all things, we have not been converted by the gospel"







Identity: I am a child & friend of God

1) Our Goal is not to 'use' God or 'be used' by God, but our Goal is to be WITH God.

2) We are called TO God.

Os Guiness "First and formost we are called to someone (God) not to something (such as motherhood or politics or teaching), or to somewhere (such as the inner city or Outer Mongolia)"

"What brings a person value, significance, and hope is not what he DOES, but WITH whom he does it.... The call to live in continued communion with od means that every person's life, no matter how mundane is elevated to sacred heights.

Are you married? Then engage your marriage WITH God and learn to love your spouse as God has loved you. Are you single? Then be single with God and devote yourself to him. Are you a mechanic? Then commune with God in your work and repair cars as a devotion to him. Are you an office worker? Then welcome Christ to your desk as you serve your employer. Are you a homemaker? Then foster a life of ceaseless prayer, ever mindful that God is with you, amid your hectic day with your family. In other words the fullness of Christ can be lived anywhere, in any circumstance, because God is WITH us. No condition in life is more honourable than another, because nothing God does lacks value. If he is with is in marriage or singleness, and in the garage, the office or the home, then these very different lives are each significant. Each of them carries the same dignity and hope." (Jethani 'WITH' p151)

So how do we live WITH God?

- Invite God into all that we do
- Look at things together WITH God & talk to God about everything
- Ask Questions to God.... What do you see? How should I respond? What is important to you? How do I respond?
- Taking time to be WITH God 'chair' time; 'watchtower' time; 'Go for a walk with God'
- See God as a friend and a helper.... 'Holy Spirit.. the counsellor...helper... will help you to pray... give you the words...'
- Our 'mission' is seeing where God is at work and joining Him,
 - Key question becomes 'God what are you doing here? What are you doing in me? Where are you at work here?
