Thinking back to when you were a child. Did someone introduce you to the faith and church? What else helped you?


## **Looking at Scripture:**

## Read Deuteronomy 6:1-9; Matthew 19:13-15 & Psalm 78:4

- What do these verses say about 'passing on the baton' and how God sees this?
- What did 'passing the baton look like for Israel' (Deuteronomy v7-9) [Note – this was written to the whole community, not just to parents]?

#### **Deuteronomy 6:7-9 Message version:**

Write these commandments that I've given you today on your hearts. Get them inside of you and then get them inside your children. Talk about them wherever you are, sitting at home or walking in the street; talk about them from the time you get up in the morning to when you fall into bed at night.



- What might it look like today? What might a 21<sup>st</sup> century description of v7-9 be?
- If you have children or grandchildren, how do you do this already? How could you do this more?

2/3
of Christians came to faith before age 18

Conversion > age 21 is rare, only 1/4 of believers

43% came to Christ < age 12

1/2 of children who come to Christ are led by parents

29% listed children's ministry as a factor
