- 4. 'If you make \$25,000 (£19,500) a year or more, you're in the top 10 percent of the world's wealth. And if you make \$34,000 (£26,700) a year or more, you're in the top 1 percent.' If you do earn this much, does it shock or surprise you to find out how wealthy you are, relatively speaking?
- Do you live by any of John Mark's 12 principles for simplicity (pp. 205–213)? Which appeals to you most, and least?
- 6. How did you feel about the suggestion of simplifying your closet/ wardrobe?
