

## Finding the 'God prepared people'/ 'people of peace' (Luke 10:1-11)

 What are the different responses that Jesus warned the disciples people would have?

• How did he tell them to respond to each?

## Finding the 'God prepared people'/ 'people of peace' (Luke 10:1-11)

Speak a blessing over them 'Peace to this house' (v5)

Reaction	How to respond?
Welcomed by a 'person of peace' (v6-9)	<ul><li>Stay with them</li><li>Proclaim and demonstrate the kingdom</li></ul>
Not welcomed (v10)	<ul> <li>'Wipe the dust off your feet' and move on.</li> </ul>

 'People of peace' often are those who open up the way to access others too (e.g. woman at the well).

### How might we today say 'peace be with you' or 'the kingdom of God is here' (p72)

- 'Can I pray for you?'
- 'Do you feel close or far away from God?'
- 'What has been your spiritual experience in the past?'
- 'Have you ever sensed something "spiritual" or something you can't explain?'
- Invite them to an event
- Share your story and God's story

### In breakout groups (p72-73)

• Any stories to share about your encounters or your '5.'?

Prayerfully thinking about your 5 people:

- Do you sense any of them are 'God prepared people'/'people of peace'?
- Do you sense any of them are people who 'open up others' to the good news too?
- Do you sense any reject you and you need to 'wipe the dust off your feet' and move on?




- Jesus continually asked questions and told stories.
- He told others to tell their stories: Read Luke 8:38-39
- Jesus calls us to tell our stories



#### Some top tips:

- Keep it simple (& short)
- Keep it focussed on Jesus not you
- Avoid religious jargon
- Be honest tell the truth about yourself & be vulnerable
- Not just 'conversion' but the little things
   God has done (me Malvern pic & Mark)
