### Dear St. Andrews & All Saints family,

When I sat down with Dave a few weeks ago for a reflection on the last 3 years, whilst we found time to celebrate all that has happened with our wonderful young people and what God's done in this season, I found myself increasingly reflecting upon actually how blessed I have been by this church community, more than anything I've given out. I therefore wanted to take an opportunity to thank a few people in particular.

Obviously the staff team of Dave, Peter, Helen, Kirsty & Sarah (as well as Doug and Anita) have been a great support, as well as the Wardens, PCCs and wider leadership team; and I am deeply thankful to all of them. I'd like to thank some of those.

Firstly, Barry and Debbie Austin, who have cared for both Hannah and I; but particularly Barry, my mentor & my friend, who has met with me or called me, every couple of weeks since I arrived in Malvern (often forcing me to join him for dog walks to subtly help me lose weight), and whose support has been indescribable for me. They've already found a caravan site near Cherry Hinton...

Then Colin and Marion Robbins, our 'landlords' (friends), whose generous hospitality enabled us to save for and afford our wedding. They've not stopped being generous to us since, and we will miss deeply our life on the farm with the best neighbours we've ever had. I shall particularly miss Colin appearing on our doorstep on regular occasions, with tears in his eyes, to tell me something new God has done this week through Alpha, CAP or just his life. (I'll also miss the Golf on my day off...).

Paul and Diana Hunt have tended deeply to my soul. Paul through Spiritual Direction, which has truly changed my life and my faith beyond recognition. Diana, and her colleague Mike, have done prayer ministry with me, picking up themes from my Psychotherapy and just affirming in me the goodness of God.

Simon Macaulay (who'll say he's my right-hand man, but really I've been his), who has been the single most encouraging person I've known in my entire life, and who met me every couple of weeks for walks during the 3 Lockdowns; pretending it was for his benefit, when really it was for mine... And has shown me how to be a Christian leader of integrity, through leading his company throughout Covid.

But on top of that there's many others. Ellie and Simon (soon to both be Noble...), and all of Hannah's life group for providing us with food when Hannah had her foot operation, and

when Oliver arrived too. Mary Flynn for providing us with all the camping equipment we could ever need to take the young people to Soul Survivor (and lovingly tidying my office a couple of times). And of course, perhaps most importantly, everyone who's ever helped out with our youth ministry, all our wonderful parents and our incredible young people – who have just been a dream to work with and be part of their journeys.

Whilst we are excited and joyful for what's ahead, it is with genuine sadness that we leave these two wonderful churches behind. Though we're certainly be with you all in the future state, I can't help but hope in this life time this is 'see you later' not 'goodbye;' but we shall leave that to God's plans and purposes.
